

#17 DICKSON FARM

The original wood structure was built in the 1880's as a dairy/livestock barn by Henry Johnson, the State Treasurer of Wisconsin. The wood structure was raised in the early 1900's and a stone and mortar foundation basement was built under the structure.

In 1966, Allen and Gloria Dickson purchased the farm. In 1970 the barn was remodeled into a dairy barn with additions in the late 70's and early 80's to add milking stalls and Heifer housing.

The barn is known for its orange tractors and large Christmas display that includes 2 large sets of bells that have been mounted on the barn for over 40 years.
