

HOLTZ FAMILY FARM



The barn was built in the late 1800's.

The farm was bought in 1917 by the grandparents of the current owners, and it was used as a dairy farm and turkey farm. They raised 3000 to 4000 turkeys a year until 1954 when the owner's Dad took over and converted it to a dairy business in 1975. They went from 35 cows to 60 cows.

In 1990 the current owners Chad and Cindy bought the farm and went to 90 cows. In 1998 they expanded to 300 cows and added a milking parlor, began cash cropping, and raising dairy steers until the present day.

This geometric John Deere block was installed by the Oconto Electric Coop on May 31st, 2017.
