ROST FARM

This farm was homesteaded by Moritz Rost in 1856 and it is now owned by the fourth generation of Rosts. The barn was built around 1925 and has never been painted. It was originally built for dairy cattle and storing hay. It is now used for steers and pigs as well as hay storage.

The barn has gone through a few remodeling projects over the years, and many family members have worked in this barn and/or still do.

This barn is the oldest in Oconto County.
